

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

National School of Judges of Ukraine

and

High School of Justice of Georgia

concerning

Cooperation on Judicial Training Activities

National School of Judges of Ukraine and **High School of Justice of Georgia** having expressed their interest in collaborating in the spirit of cooperation, goodwill and friendship between them in order to mutual exchange of experiences on institutional development, teaching methodologies and other issues related to Judicial Trainings

and

wishing to formalize their relationship to strengthen joint efforts to mutual support have agreed to the following:

Article 1. Purpose

1.1. The Memorandum aims to establish a cooperative relationship between the parties within which the parties will support:

- the further organisational development of the parties;
- the exchange of experience in the field of judicial training.

1.2. This Memorandum is not intended to create any legal obligations under domestic or international law.

Article 2. Area of Cooperation

2.1. Collaboration between the parties would address country-specific and regional issues in a wide array of thematic areas, including:

- initial and continuous judicial training of Judges and Court Professions;
- organisational development of the parties.

Article 3. Instruments of Cooperation

3.1. The Parties will arrange mutual meetings on a regular basis, to keep each other

informed of and consult on matters of common interest related to this Memorandum.

3.2. Where needed exchange relevant documents and other sources of information to make the other Party aware on developments in the area of collaboration.

3.3. Identify focal points at each institution to facilitate cooperation and exchange of information.

3.4. Develop plan and conduct common activities in order to further develop Parties' activities.

Article 4. Evaluation of the implementation

4.1. In order to monitor the implementation of this Memorandum the parties will:

- Document common meetings, delivered information and requests for information;
- Document impacts of information;
- Evaluate the effectiveness and efficiency of the cooperation on a regular basis.

Article 5. Termination Clause

5.1. This Memorandum will come into force from the date of its signature and valid indefinitely.

5.2. If either party wishes to terminate this Memorandum that Party must give 1 month written notice to the other.

5.3. This Memorandum was made in Kyiv on December 18, 2015 in two original copies in English, each of which kept by each of the Parties being authentic.
